

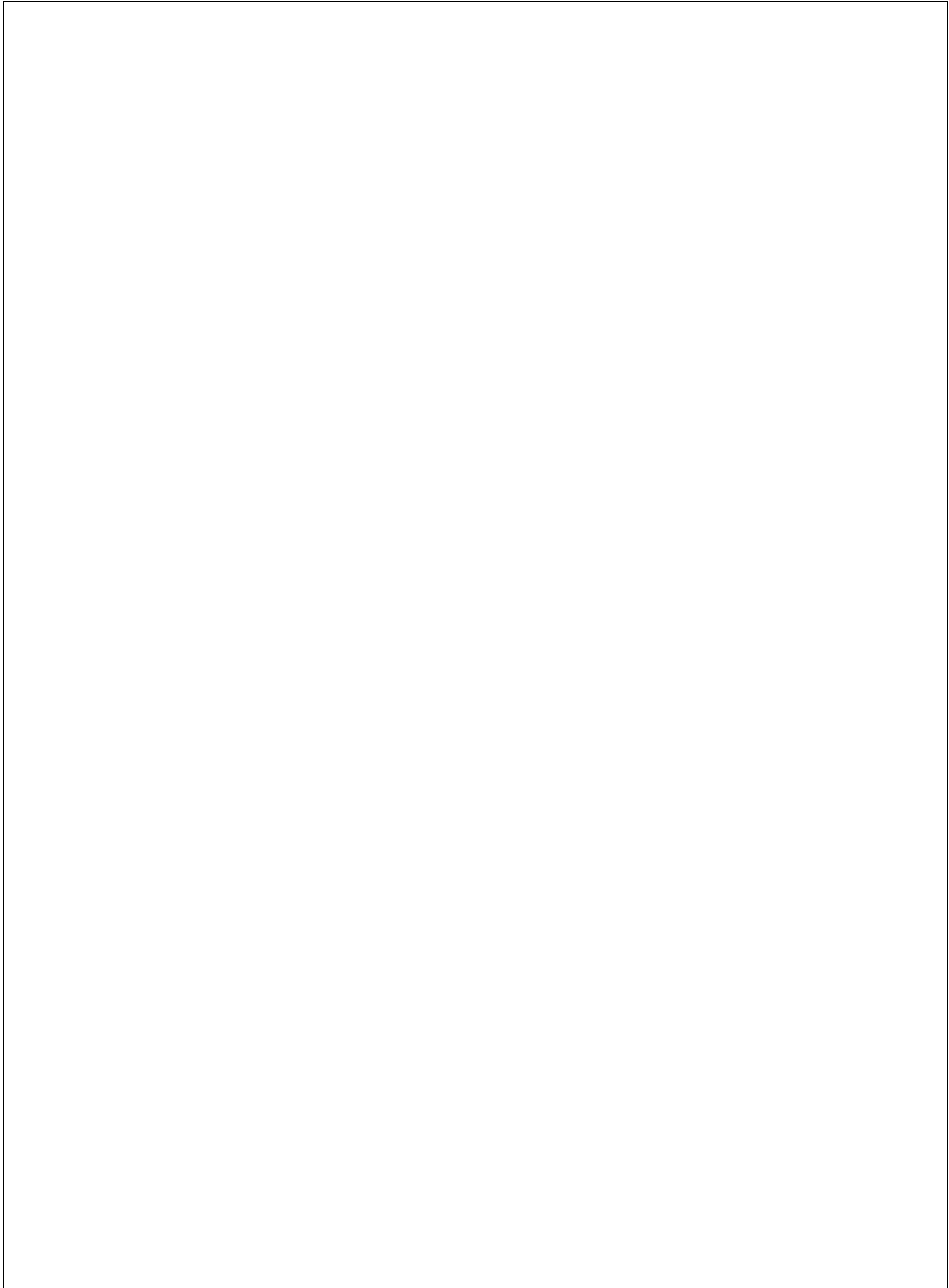

That brings a wave of feels

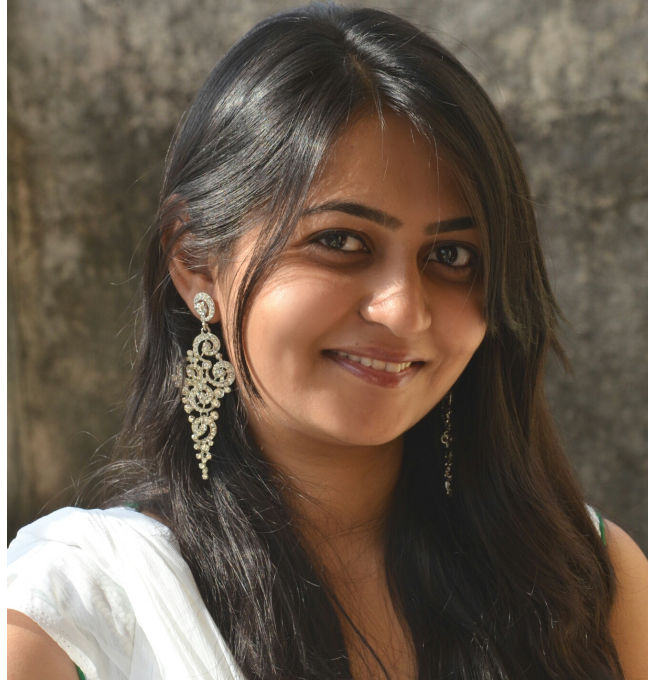
